DUST CONTROL

Basic Dust Control Training (3 – 4 Hour Course)

Basic Dust Control Training is for site superintendents and water truck/water-pull drivers at dust-generating operations at sites having more than one acre but less than five acres of disturbed surface area. This training requirement is for dust-generating operations within Maricopa County.

The permittee for these sites is required to have at least one Basic Dust Control trained site superintendent or designated person at each site. Water truck and water-pull drivers must also complete this training class. Maricopa County additionally requires that site superintendents, water truck and water-pull drivers must complete this training class once every three years.

Permittees must maintain a written record of the names of employees who successfully completed the Basic Dust Control Training Class. The requirement for having persons on-site with the Basic Dust Control training goes into effect on December 31, 2008.

Persons completing the Basic Dust Control Training Class will have a good understanding and awareness of the complex fugitive dust control requirements within Maricopa County.

Comprehensive Dust Control Training (8 Hour Course)

The Comprehensive Dust Control training class is for Dust Control Coordinators working at dust-generating operations in Maricopa County having five or more acres of disturbed surface area. Dust Control Coordinators must complete this training class once every three years and have a valid Comprehensive Dust Control training certification identification card readily accessible on-site.

The permittee for these sites is required to have at least one Dust Control Coordinator on-site at all times during dust-generating operations. The requirement for having a Dust Control Coordinator on-site went into effect on June 30, 2008.

Persons completing the Comprehensive Dust Control Training class will have a good understanding and awareness of the complex fugitive dust control requirements within Maricopa County.
